

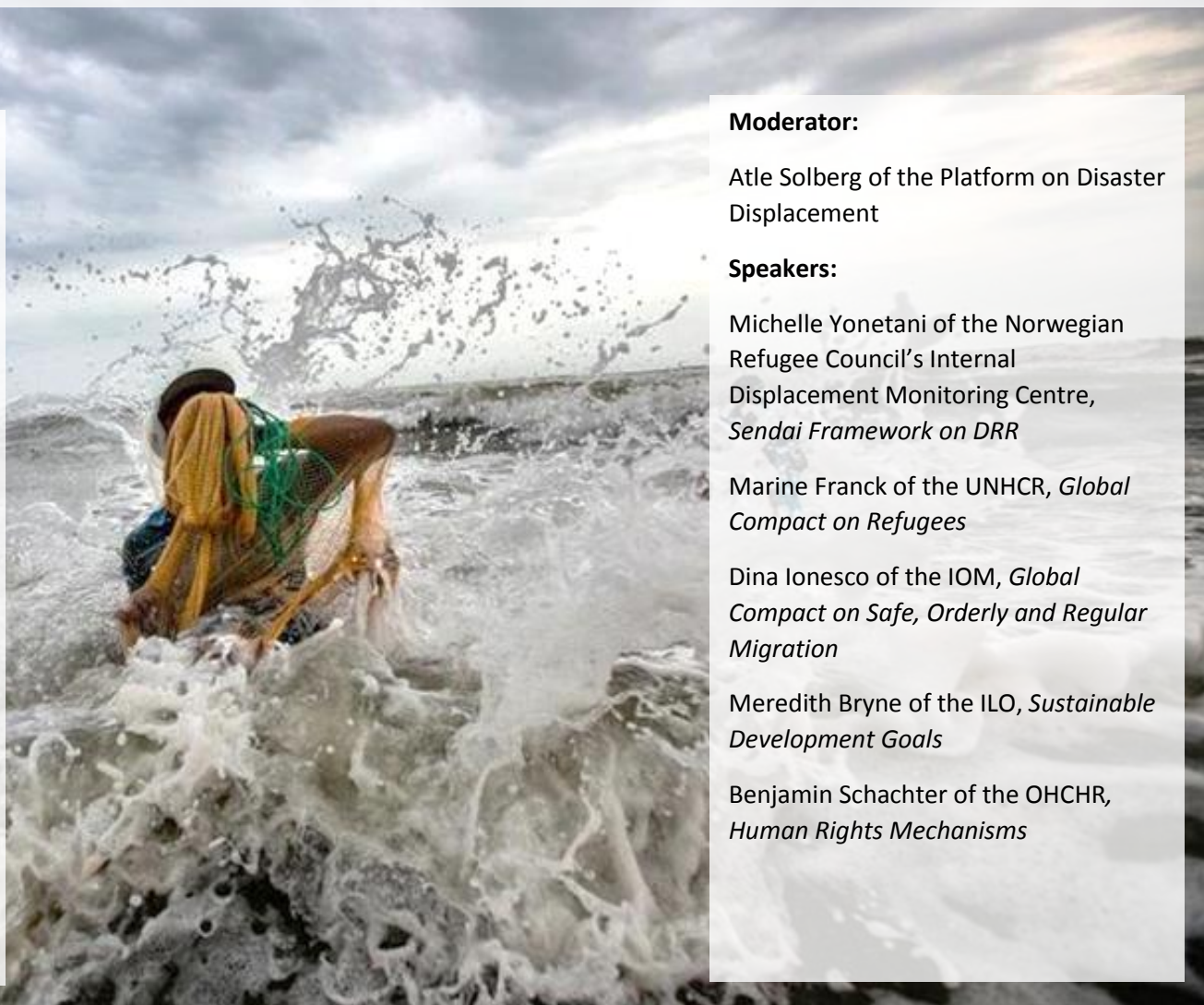
# Human Mobility and Climate Change: Synergies between UNFCCC and other global policy processes

Side Event at the Bonn Climate Change Conference in May 2017

At COP21, it was decided to establish a Task Force on Displacement under the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage to develop recommendations to **avert, minimize and address displacement** related to the adverse effects of climate change.

This event takes stock of the policy processes that complement and supplement the work of the Task Force, including: the Platform on Disaster Displacement and follow up to **Nansen Initiative Protection Agenda**, implementation of the **Sendai Framework on Disaster Risk Reduction**, development of the **Global Compacts on Refugees** and the **Global Compact of Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration**, achievement of the **Sustainable Development Goals**, and the **mechanisms of the Human Rights Council** related to climate change.

This event will emphasize the synergies between these other policy processes and the climate change negotiations, reflect on how to ensure policy coherence, and highlight the specific value added of the UNFCCC process with regards to human mobility in the context of climate change.
